#### CITATION REQUIREMENTS

To earn an Earth, Life & Time (ELT) Scholars Citation, you must model good community citizenship and complete 17-23 credits with a minimum grade point average of 3.0 in Scholars ELT citation courses (including ENGL 101), and a minimum cumulative grade point average of 2.5 in all courses at UM during the two-year period of the Scholars program. If you are exempt from ENGL 101, you must complete 14-20 credits. These credits must be satisfied during the two-year period of the Scholars Program (4 semesters). All students are expected to comply with the University's Code of Academic Integrity.
