#### CITATION REQUIREMENTS

To earn an Arts Scholars Citation, you must model good community citizenship and complete 16 credits with an overall average GPA of 3.0 in designated Scholars courses, including ENGL 101. If you are exempt from ENGL 101, you must complete 13 credits. These credits must be satisfied during the two-year period of the Scholars Program (4 semesters). All students are expected to comply with the University's Code of Academic Integrity.

#### Supporting Courses (Total of 9 credits in 3 different departments)

- Complete at least one course from the Scholars Arts First Year List:

- Complete two courses (six credits) beginning with one of the prefixes ARTH, ARTT, DANC, MUET, MUSC, MUSP, THET, or any literature or creative writing course in ENGL (including the above CPS Arts First Year List) or the following recommended courses:

Note: CORE designation is in parentheses. Not all courses in ARTH, ARTT, DANC, ENGL, MUSC, MUET, MUSP, and THET satisfy CORE. Students can receive CORE credit for only two CORE HA courses; any additional courses count as **electives** unless they are major requirements.
