**We want to remind you that as Life Science Scholars you must register for specific Scholars sections if they are offered (marked with an "S" at the end of the course number, i.e. CHEM 232S) unless you get permission from the Scholars Life Sciences Director Assistant Director to do otherwise. Therefore, if you are registering for BSCI 105 (a requirement to receive your Scholars citation) and/or CHEM 232 (not required for a Scholars citation) this Spring, you MUST register for the "S" sections of these courses (BSCI 105S and CHEM 232S); the seats have been reserved for LS Scholars. If you plan to take one of these courses but have a REQUIRED major course which conflicts with these scheduled sections, you must have the permission of the Scholars Life Sciences Director or Assistant Director to register for a non-S section of BSCI 105 or CHEM 232.
