#### CITATION REQUIREMENTS

To earn an International Studies Scholars Citation, you must model good community citizenship and complete 15-16 credits with an overall average GPA of 3.0 in designated Scholars courses, including ENGL 101, **and** a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 in all courses at UM during the two-year period of the Scholars Program. These credits must be satisfied during the two-year period of the Scholars Program (4 semesters). All students are expected to comply with the University's Code of Academic Integrity.
