Award Requirements & Application Form Citation Class of 2009

The Ira Berlin Writing Award honors a Scholar who has demonstrated excellence in writing during their freshman or sophomore year. Submissions may be made from the fields of technical or creative writing. Please note that poetry submissions require at least three writing samples.

Nominations may be made by any member of the College Park Scholars community, including faculty, staff, instructors, Resident Life officials, and students. Self-nominations are encouraged and welcome.

----- Requirements -----

- Applicants must be cleared for their College Park Scholars citation by their program faculty no later than August 14, 2009;
- Applicants are limited to one submission (or a packet of three submissions for poetry);
- Writing sample must be from a course that counts toward the College Park Scholars citation (i.e., Scholars colloquia, English 101, CPSP courses, and/or supporting courses);
- Writing sample must be typed;
- Writing sample must be clean of instructor comments;
- Applicants must submit a copy of the completed application form and the previously referenced attachments.
