Award Requirements & Application Form Citation Class of 2009

The Katherine McAdams Leadership Award honors a young woman who has proven to be an effective leader among Scholars during her freshman and sophomore years. This award recognizes leadership that is demonstrated through appointed, elected, or voluntary positions. Applicants should demonstrate a sense of civic duty and social responsibility as she practices leadership in an inclusive, empowering and ethical manner.

Nominations may be made by any member of the College Park Scholars community, including faculty, staff, instructors, Resident Life officials, and students. Self-nominations are encouraged and welcome.

- Applicants must be cleared for their College Park Scholars citation by their program faculty no later than August 14, 2009;
- Applicants must submit an essay of no more than two pages, double spaced and type written, addressing their merit for this award;
- Applicants must submit a résumé which highlights positional leadership and responsibilities;
- Applicants must submit at least one letter of recommendation from a campus faculty or staff member who can attest to their merit for the award;
- Applicants must submit a copy of the completed application form and the previously referenced attachments.
