## Award Requirements & Application Form Citation Class of 2009

- Applicants must be cleared for their College Park Scholars citation by their program faculty no later than August 14, 2009;
- Applicants must submit a reflection paper of at least two pages that reflects an innovative idea which inspired an event, project or performance benefiting Scholars and/or the wider community;
- Applicants must provide evidence of their creativity in the form of an artifact (website, paper, project, album, photographs, portfolio, etc.);
- Applicants must submit a copy of the completed application form and the previously referenced attachments.
