The Peres Award for Scholars Study Abroad honors a Scholar who has displayed an interest in international and global affairs. Applicants should exhibit scholarly attitudes, display academic excellence, and demonstrate learning as a result of having studied abroad.

Nominations may be made by any member of the College Park Scholars community, including faculty, staff, instructors, Resident Life officials, and students. Self-nominations are encouraged and welcome.

----- Requirements -----

- Applicants must be cleared for their College Park Scholars citation by their program faculty no later than August 14, 2009;
- Applicants must submit a copy of their unofficial transcript;
- Applicants must submit coursework from their study-abroad experience, in the form of a paper, Website, or PowerPoint presentation. The coursework should demonstrate what they learned as related to the course learning objectives;
- Applicants must submit a reflective essay, no more than two pages, double-spaced and type-written, pertaining to how the study-abroad experience affected their image of others in the world, or how the experience has had an impact on their learning, selection of major, or professional goals;
- Applicants must submit a copy of the completed application form and the previously referenced attachments.
