Award Requirements & Application Form

An alumna of the College Park Scholars program in Public Leadership, Meghan Price embodied the qualities of leadership, dedication, and involvement in the community. The Meghan Price Scholarship Award for Leadership and Public Service honors her legacy and promise. Whether Meghan was instructing an individual through her volunteer efforts with the Blind Skiers Program at Wisp Mountain, or representing the 24,000 undergraduates as Maryland's Student Government Association President, Meghan assured us all that her generation would deliver a new kind of leadership.

In December 1998, Meghan's life ended in a tragic car accident. At that time, Meghan was enrolled in the departmental honors program in Government and Politics; she had recently received the prestigious Bryan M. Gardner Public Policy award. Her plans were to attend law school and enter a career in public service.

Nominations may be made by any member of the College Park Scholars community, including faculty, staff, instructors, Resident Life officials, and students. Self-nominations are encouraged and welcome.

- Applicants must be current undergraduates at the University of Maryland, having earned their College Park Scholars citation no later than December 31, 2008;
- Though applications are strongly encouraged from Public Leadership citation recipients, the scholarship is open to all College Park Scholars;
- Applicants must submit an essay of no more than two pages, double spaced and type written, addressing their merit for this award in the areas of leadership and public service;
- Applicants must attach a competitive résumé and an unofficial transcript;
- Applicants must attach at least one letter of recommendation from a campus faculty or staff member who can attest to their merit for the award;
- Applicants must submit a copy of the completed application form and the previously referenced attachments.
