The Nancy and Ira Shapiro Excellence in Undergraduate Research Award honors a Scholar who has demonstrated excellence through a Undergraduate Research Project in Scholars. This project must demonstrate active collaboration between a faculty mentor and the student and fulfill the mission of Discovery, which is to encourage students to dig into primary sources and unearth interesting questions for further exploration. The project must also have resulted in questions or activities that the student and/or faculty mentor may pursue through further research.

Nominations may be made by any member of the College Park Scholars community, including faculty, staff, instructors, Resident Life officials, and students. Self-nominations are encouraged and welcome.

- Applicants must be cleared for their College Park Scholars citation by their program faculty no later than August 14, 2009;
- Applicants must submit an abstract of the research project;
- Applicants must submit examples or descriptions of the primary sources that were investigated;
- Applicants must submit a detailed description of their research methodology;
- Applicants must submit a list of questions for further study;
- Applicants must submit a copy of the completed application form and the previously referenced attachments.
