- Applicants must submit an essay of no more than two pages, double spaced and type written, addressing their merit for this award in the areas of academic excellence, community contributions, and the value of diversity to their learning;
- Applicants must attach a competitive résumé and an unofficial transcript;
- Applicants must attach at least one letter of recommendation from a campus faculty or staff member who can attest to their merit for the award;
- Applicants must submit a copy of the completed application form and the previously referenced attachments.
