

SEMESTER ACADEMIC HONORS **BY UM COLLEGE/SCHOOL**

<u>COLLEGE OF AGRICULTURE AND NATURAL RESOURCES</u>	The Animal and Avian Sciences Department within the College of Agriculture and Natural Resources publishes a Dean's List comprised of a subset of student ANSC majors Consult the College's advising office in 0107 Symons Hall.
<u>SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE, PLANNING AND PRESERVATION</u>	Students' academic records are monitored for those meeting the academic guidelines as set forth by the University policy. A mailing is issued from the Dean to all students meeting the University's criteria.
<u>COLLEGE OF ARTS AND HUMANITIES</u>	The College of Arts and Humanities sends a letter from the Dean congratulating students who make the Dean's List by satisfying the University's Semester Academic Honors criteria. In addition, all students who are eligible for Commencement Honors (Summa Cum Laude, Magna Cum Laude and Cum Laude) receive a red tassel from the College.
<u>COLLEGE OF BEHAVIORAL AND SOCIAL SCIENCES</u>	BSOS recognizes students with a semester GPA of 3.50 to 3.99 on the Dean's List and 4.0 students on the Distinguished Dean's List. The students receive a 4x6 certificate. In addition, students' names are posted on a designated bulletin board in Tydings Hall. Graduating seniors who have earned 60 UM credits with a minimum 3.9 cumulative GPA are recognized as Dean Academic Scholars. These students are recognized at the annual spring BSOS Awards event. December graduates receive a letter from the Dean and a certificate.
<u>ROBERT H. SMITH SCHOOL OF BUSINESS</u>	The Smith School recognizes students who meet the University's semester academic honors criteria (Dean's List) and post their names on a website at http://www.rhsmith.umd.edu/undergrad/deanslist.html .
<u>COLLEGE OF CHEMICAL AND LIFE SCIENCES</u>	All CLFS students who earn at least a 3.80 in the preceding fall or spring semester are invited to a special celebration with the Dean in April of each year. They are encouraged to invite a faculty member to attend as their guest. Students are awarded a certificate at the event.
<u>COLLEGE OF COMPUTER, MATHEMATICAL AND PHYSICAL SCIENCES</u>	The dean signs a letter to those who earn semester academic honors and are recognized as having made the Dean's List. Another letter is sent to students who earn between a 3.0 - 3.49; they are recognized as being on the Associate Dean's List with the Associate Dean's signature. Lists are posted in the glass enclosed case outside of the CMPS Undergraduate suite.
<u>COLLEGE OF EDUCATION</u>	The College of Education sends a letter from the Dean congratulating students who make the Dean's List by satisfying the University's Semester Academic Honors criteria.
<u>A. JAMES CLARK SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING</u>	The Engineering School sends a letter from the Dean congratulating students who make the <u>Dean's List</u> by satisfying the University's Semester Academic Honors criteria.
<u>SCHOOL OF PUBLIC HEALTH</u>	Historically, Dean's Lists have been posted in each department, the Student Service Center, and the Dean's Office. Additionally, students may receive a letter from the College, congratulating them on their academic performance.
<u>PHILIP MERRILL COLLEGE OF JOURNALISM</u>	The Philip Merrill College of Journalism sends a letter from the Dean congratulating students who make the Dean's List by satisfying the University's Semester Academic Honors criteria. Names are posted on the College's Web site.
<u>ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT PROGRAMS, INDIVIDUAL STUDIES PROGRAM, LETTERS & SCIENCES</u>	Individual letters are sent to students by the <u>Dean for Undergraduate Studies</u> .
